Birmingham International airport

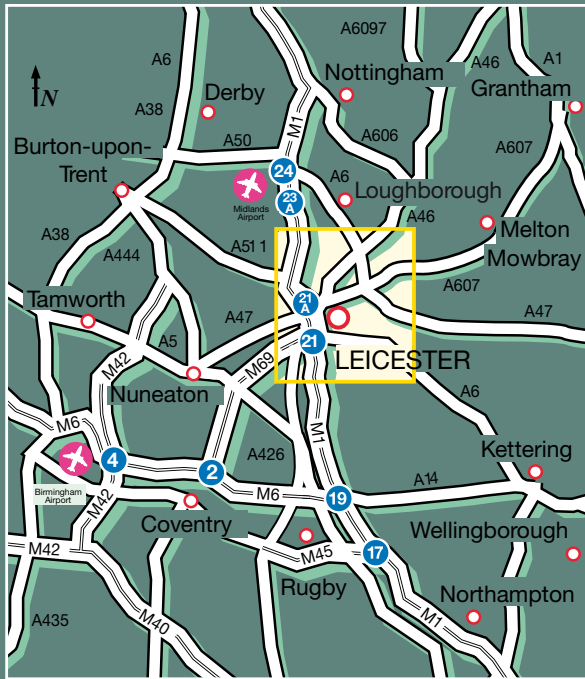
Situated at junction 26 (M42). Journey time approximately 60 minutes.
